USA - Families in Somerton will now have a new home sweet home. The National Farm Workers Service Center hosted a grand opening this afternoon for low income families.

Hacienda Manuel Chavez will give housing to families of four or more that earn less than 25-thousand dollars a year.

The 80-unit town houses include two to four bedrooms, individual laundry facilities, a play area and a community technology center.

Families living in the new homes were happy to have a place they can call home.

The housing project is named after Manuel Chavez cousin of Cesar Chavez a farmworker union organizer during the late sixties.

Family members of Chavez were invited to receive an award.
